BACKGROUND

Social and economic changes are social realities that keep occurring in the life of the world's society. These changes are triggered by the development of technology and information which brings impacts to the country's development process. A country is categorized as a developing country if, in achieving the goals of the development, it is able to balance what has been achieved in the implemented development so most of the goals, both the physical and non-physical ones, are realized. Industrialization continues in the life of the world's society. It is marked with the process of socioeconomic changes transforming the system of agricultural society into that of industrial one. Industrialization has changed the society's life to be focused on the occupations which become more specialised and offer higher earnings. In the meantime the changes in its human's philosophy which gives more emphasis on the rationality of acting based on the consideration, efficiency, as well as estimation, and not on only moral, emotion, habits, and traditions anymore also occurs. The industrialization era in the 21st century can create polarization where humans become smart, technologically advanced, and highly paid.
